


Thank You

You've Made a Difference

Thanks to the generosity of our supporters, the children of St. Francis Xavier Haitian Orphanage have had a year of food, shelter, education, love and hope. For fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 87% of the total expenditures were for direct support of the Orphanage in Haiti. 10% of the expenditures were for fundraising, including travel for Cenat, newsletter, pancake breakfast, and Host for Hait. 3% of the expenditures were for administration which include wire transfer fees, postage and office supplies. The Foundation places the highest priority on responsible financial management.

Siena College once again provided the venue for one of the most exciting nights on the St. Francis Xavier Haitian Orphanage Foundation's calendar. The second edition of Host for Haiti took place at Siena's New Hall on Saturday October 18th and raised over \$35,000.

This year's theme was "Hear My Voice, Tell My Story." The voices of the eighteen children could be heard throughout the night. Whether in conversation with Orphanage Director, Esperandeu Cenat or watching the singing and dancing of the children played on the large screen, guests of the event could almost feel the children in the room. Aiding to this experience were ginormous "fatheads" of the children which lined the room and a performance by the St. Pius X third and fourth grade choir.

The night begun with a cocktail reception at Siena College which provided appetizers and beverages. The reception included speeches from Cenat, Siena Chief of Staff Father Ken Paulli and Foundation Vice President John Hayes. The Foundation also celebrated the kick-off of the Sponsor-a-Child Program which generated a lot of excitement around this new opportunity to connect with the children of the Orphanage on a more personal level.

After the reception, guests attended dinners at their host homes. Over twenty different homes throughout the Capital Region participated this year. The Foundation greatly appreciates the generosity of these host families, Siena College and it's many sponsors for making Host for Haiti a great success.

President's Message



Temple University's Project Haiti

Temple Project Haiti is a student run organization at Temple University that fundraises for the orphanage and visits each year to create lasting relationships and improve the overall quality of life for the children they have come to love. They were the first group of college students to visit the orphanage and this coming March of 2015 will be their fourth trip. Last year their fundraising efforts were able to build a new kitchen with a concrete floor, reducing the risk of food borne illness. This year, they are starting a skill building initiative called the Chicken Project, through which the children will learn to raise and sell chickens.

This will not only provide practical skills but hopes to empower them to work together outside of the classroom. Project Haiti is looking to raise \$5,000 this year.





It is with great pleasure that we are announcing the launch of our new Sponsor A Child program.


